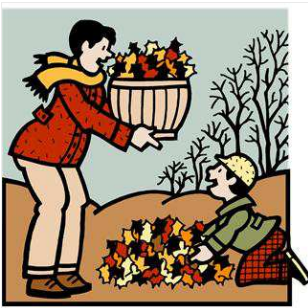

What do the words mean?

investigate — If you investigate you try to find out about something.

reply — If you reply you give an answer.

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
