

Fun Ambiguous Images

Have a look at this Necker cube...




The cube can be seen in two different ways: facing down and to the left or up and to the right




This illusion is known as "Rubin's Vase," though the image could also be accurately described as "Rubin's faces. Can you see both the faces and the vase?
