**Learning Intention:** To be able to say and spell my spelling words.

2. Write a sentence in your jotter for each of your words to show your understanding of their meaning. Underline your spelling word in each sentence. For example, I had one piece of chocolate today.
3. Choose a spelling activity of your choice and practice spelling your words. For example, rainbow words, pyramid writing, hidden picture...
4. Write some numbers and then try to write the number in words beside it.

For example, 1 = one
