


We will be flexible and work with you so that each child has the time and support necessary to settle in securely and attend a session happily on their own.


Our Nursery times are:


Monday - Thursday: 8.30-3.15pm ___ Friday: 8.30- 11.30am

- Supporting children in solving conflict.
- Being approachable and consistent in our behaviour management approaches.
 - Explain and model acceptable behaviour.
- Help children to find positive ways to deal with their feelings.
 - Re-focus them on choosing a more positive activity.
 - Support them to try and resolve conflict situations.
