Catholic Education Week



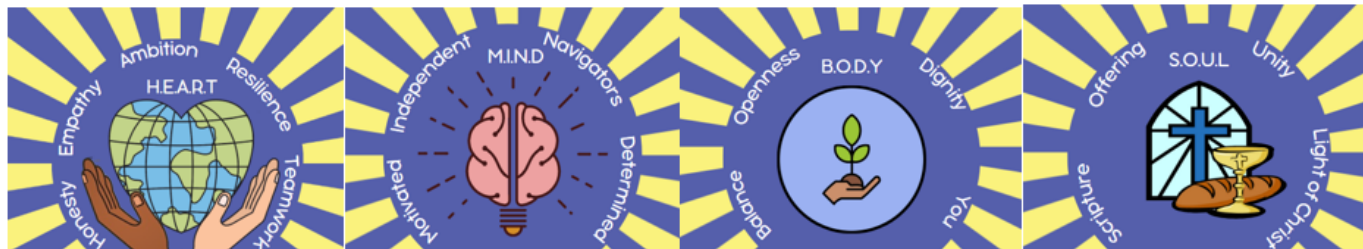
We will be having a special assembly today to celebrate the start of **Catholic Education Week** on Sunday 16th November (Feast of St Margaret of Scotland).
